The Changing Landscape of Green Building Requirements

The evolution of green building codes and standards, climate change and other environmental concerns are changing not only the way homes and commercial buildings are designed, constructed and sited, they are driving obligations that manufacturers of building materials and assemblies declare the cradle to grave environmental impacts of their products including how those declarations must be made.
