**Senator John Hoeven (R-ND)

John Hoeven became North Dakota's 22nd U.S. Senator in 2011, after serving 10 years as governor of the state. Through his positions on the Senate Appropriations, Energy and Agriculture Committees, Sen. Hoeven is working to implement the same kinds of policies on a national level that have helped to grow and diversify North Dakota's economy and to create jobs on the state level. Sen. Hoeven is a leading advocate of developing a national energy policy that encourages development of both traditional and renewable resources and reducing our budget deficits and national debt.



Congressman Greg Walden (R-OR)

Rep. Greg Walden represents Oregon's Second Congressional District and is member of House Republican leadership team. He serves as chairman of the House Republican Leadership and is a GOP deputy whip. Rep.
